Day 1: Lima

Once there, you will visit the impressive Santo Domingo Convent, which will astonish you with its colonial style. NIGHT VISIT TO MAGIC FOUNTAINS OF LIMA

You will visit the impressive Magic Water Circuit, the largest fountain complex in the world, which is why it won the famous Guinness World Record. The main pool, called the "Magic Fountain" launches a jet of water that reaches a height of 80 meters. You can go through the "Tunnel of Surprises", about 35 meters long; the "Kids Fountain", which has an irresistible water system to play with; or the "Enchanted Labyrinth" fountain, which will allow you to discover a labyrinth formed by walls of water with different visual effects. Then, You will be dropped off at your hotel in Lima.

Then, continue towards the town of Pisac to tour its impressive archaeological site on the mountain top, one of the most important in the Valley, featuring incredible terraced hillsides and a high degree of urban planning. After the tour, you will descend to the town and spend some time in the local market, interacting with the people, observing the local identity, and doing a little shopping. **Enjoy a great lunch served at one of the best restaurants in Sacred Valley, taste a delicious lunch accompanied by a**

You will participate in a ceramics workshop: Ceramicas Seminario, a renowned ceramist from Urubamba, who is famous for manufacturing beautiful pieces. You will learn various techniques, which are used to create ceramic pieces that have been inspired in colonial and Andean art.

After that, a magnificent adventure by mountain bike. First, a descent to the Moray archaeological complex, consisting of several concentric terraces that were used by the Incas as a farming laboratory. Then on to Maras, enjoying the open road and impressive views of the mountains along with a great picnic lunch served. Then comes a climb to the Maras salt mines, where salt has been extracted for thousands of years. Finally, transport to your hotel. *Included: Cooler with water and snacks for passengers.*

CITY TOUR WITH CHOCOLATE MAKING CLASSES AND VISIT SACSAYHUAMAN

Being in Peru, a producer of many of the fine cacao varieties in the world, learn all the steps to make chocolate, from harvest of the cacao in a plantation to the production of a chocolate bar. You will roast the cacao beans, peel them and grind them to produce a paste. This cacao paste was used to prepare the first known cacao drink, the traditional hot chocolate. You will be able to take your own chocolate home. We will continue with our visit of the city of Cusco, a World Heritage Site by Unesco and place of a particular essence. The tour will go through the temple of Koricancha, and ancient Inca palace and main worship center of the god sun, there, the order of the Dominicans built a precious church that lies at the top. Then we head the Plaza de Armas, where you can find the Cathedral. After this you will visit the fortress of Sacsayhuaman, Inca building known for its massive walls

of hewn stone, placed in a strategic location, on a hill with a wide view of the city Cuzco. *Included: Cooler with water and snacks for passengers.*

NIGHT DISCOVERY OF THE ANDEAN COSMOVISION AT THE PLANETARIUM OF CUSCO

You will live a one-of-a-kind experience at the Planetarium Cusco -located 15 minutes from the city- where you will learn about the important relationship between the Andean man and the cosmos.
